Previous Meeting Minutes Reviewed: The meeting minutes were reviewed from the December 12, 2007 meeting. The motion to accept the meeting minutes as presented was first and seconded.

Fundraising: Sub Orders are due back on January 27 and January 29 for the Cheerleaders and Wrestlers respectively. Orders will then be delivered to the High School at 4:00pm on February 7. Pickup will be at that time. A Bowl-A-Rama planning meeting will be held on January 17 at 6:30pm at Hennigans.

Website/Media Update: We received 14 player registrations through the online system. Of those 14, we received 3 additional donations totaling \$20.00. The website saw 300 visitors in December and Month to date for January was 136 visitors. The total visitors, since the end of August 2006, are 8,465.

New Business: A Senators group party for all baseball teams was suggested again. The board agreed that it is a good idea and suggested that the party date be moved closer to the middle of June to get more players involved.
